



COLLEGE UNIFORM NOTES

Students are expected to wear the full uniform at all times, including while travelling to and from College. Parents should ensure that their children wear the uniform as specified in the uniform lists. If any item of uniform cannot be worn, an explanatory note must be sent to the class teacher.

Parents should only purchase listed uniform items from the College approved supplier:

**Some items of uniform may be difficult to purchase at short notice and parents are encouraged to buy items well before they are required.

- Students are allowed to wear extra layers under their uniform as long as it is not visible.
- There are no options for colour or style unless specified in these lists.

UNIFORM EXPECTATIONS - General

- Black leather lace up school shoes only to be worn. (Velcro is allowed for Prep-Year 1). Shoes must be polished.
- Top button is to be buttoned when tie is worn. (Please purchase shirts with a fused collar for use with a tie).
- Ties must be worn with winter uniform.
- Jumper and blazer sleeves to be kept down, NOT rolled up or wrapped around the waist.
- The Blazer must be worn to and from College with the school uniform for years 7-12.
- Hats are compulsory part of the uniform. In Term 1 and Term 4 it is compulsory to wear a hat when outside. (The preferred hat is the Surf Hat. The St Andrews College cap is acceptable for years 7-12).
- Shirts are to be tucked in.
- No visible jewellery to be worn – rings, bracelets, necklaces etc or these will be confiscated.
- Only natural hair colours are acceptable.

UNIFORM & HAIR EXPECTATIONS - Girls

- Girls' dresses and skirts must be to the knee.
- In summer, girls may wear short white socks above the ankle. Not to be confused with anklet socks.
- No make-up or nail polish to be worn.
- One pair of gold, silver studs or sleepers only, worn in the lobe, is acceptable for girls with pierced ears. No stones or differing shapes allowed.
- Fringes are to be kept well clear of eyes. Where girls' hair falls below shoulder level it must be tied back at all times to keep it clear off the face.
- Hair accessories must be in College colours.

UNIFORM & HAIR EXPECTATIONS – Boys

- Trousers – jeans type grey trousers are not acceptable
- Boys not to wear anklet socks
- Hair is to be conservatively shaped and graded. Undercuts and overhanging sides and fringes are unacceptable. Hair is graded well off the collar. If hair is crew cut, no lower than No.3 cutters to be used.

FULL Summer or Winter Uniform, NOT a combination of both must be worn in the appropriate season.
