* Levies cover the cost of items such as:

- Teaching materials including photocopying work sheets, art room and stationery supplies
- Prescribed excursions (Year 12 students will be charged for excursions as they occur)
- Swimming program
- Transportation and facility hire for sports events
- Camps
- Information Technology
- School Diary
- House T-shirt (2018 only)
- Text Book Hire - to eliminate the cost of purchasing expensive text books the College runs a Text Book Hire scheme. Parents pay an annual levy instead of being required to purchase text books. Students are allocated text books which they use and return at the end of the year. An additional charge may be made if books are lost or returned in a poor condition. Students studying VCE subjects are required to purchase their own text books.

NOTE: Excursions/camps are an integral part of the curriculum and the applicable levies are non-refundable.

APPLICATION FEE

A non-refundable charge of \$100 (including GST) is payable when lodging an Application for Enrolment.

ENROLMENT FEE

A non-refundable enrolment fee of \$1,400 per student is payable on acceptance of enrolment. \$1,000 of the non-refundable Enrolment Agreement Fee will then be deducted from tuition fees for the first term of enrolment.

FEE PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS

The College will charge the total yearly tuition fees and levies at the commencement of the year. Parents are required to register with the College to enable automatic monthly payments to be made which will be processed on the 20th of each month. There will be 10 monthly payments (February to November) with a final payment in December to clear any outstanding balance. **A Direct Debit Authority form will be issued with the school fee account issued in February. Payments can be processed from bank accounts (cheque or savings) and credit cards (Visa and Mastercard only).**

BURSARY ASSISTANCE

There are limited funds available to provide bursary assistance to parents who find themselves in financial need and may need help in paying the school fees. Information and application forms are available from the College office.

BUILDING FUND

Families are invited to donate \$500 each year to the Building Fund. A voluntary charge of \$500 will be added to the fee account. If you do not wish to make this donation or would like to donate a different amount, please advise the accounts department and your account will be adjusted accordingly.

All donations to the Building Fund of \$2 and over are tax deductible. A receipt for tax purposes will be issued in June of each year.

SIBLING DISCOUNTS

The following discounts on tuition fees will apply to siblings provided that accounts are paid by the due date:

SECOND CHILD 10% discount

THIRD CHILD 40% discount

FOURTH CHILD Free

BOOKLISTS

To ensure that the correct stationery and text books are supplied for students in Prep to Year 6, the College will arrange for Link Educational to supply these items direct to the College and charge parents for the associated cost. Parents of students in these Year levels will not need purchase any stationery or textbooks. An additional charge for the Booklist supplies for Prep to Year 6 will be added to the fee account.

Booklists for Years 7 to 12 will be distributed with details of the required textbooks and stationery. We would recommend that you purchased these from Link Educational; however, you are able to purchase them from other suppliers if you wish.

PARENT PARTICIPATION

The College Board seeks to keep the tuition fees as low as possible. We are greatly helped in achieving this objective by parents' involvement in the Parent Participation scheme on an on-going basis and/or regular attendance at working bees. Families can participate in the scheme by being involved in a variety of activities. During the year notices will be sent out requesting parent help at various events or activities, for example, helping at sports carnivals, covering library books, classroom help or attending working bees.

Parents are required to record the hours they have completed in the Parent Hours Book which is kept in the College Office. You will be charged a Parent Participation fee of \$250 at the commencement of each year and will be credited at the end of each semester for any work done. You will be credited at a rate of \$25 per hour of work completed, up to a maximum of \$250 for the year. The time requirement for each family is ten hours per year.
